

The counter, carved in stone.

Android-native business hardware, pre-flashed with the Kardopal platform — a till, a kitchen screen, a kiosk and a scanner that all report to one account.

THE PLATFORM

Everything the business does, in one login.

Most businesses run on six subscriptions that do not speak to each other: a till here, books there, stock in a spreadsheet, the team on a chat app. Kardopal is the alternative — one account, one set of records, every module reading the same truth.

- **30 modules**

Sales, stock, books, people, service, commerce — all first-class, none bolted on.

- **One record, everywhere**

A price changed once is changed at the till, in the catalogue and on the invoice.

- **21 languages**

Arabic, Persian and Kurdish right-to-left down to the last screen.

- **Phone-first**

Every module has real screens in the hand, not a cut-down companion app.



BUSINESS SUITE

The operating core.

The modules a business touches daily. They share one customer list, one catalogue and one ledger, so nothing needs re-typing between them.

- **Sales**
Quotes to orders to invoices, with tax and discount at line and document level.
- **Items**
Products, variants, brands, price lists, units and suppliers in one catalogue.
- **Inventory**
Warehouses, bins, batches, serials and movements — what you have and what is promised.
- **Accounting**
Expenses, bills, bank accounts, transactions and tax rates.



SALES

From a quote to money in the bank.

One document flow. An estimate becomes an order, an order becomes an invoice, and each step keeps the line items, the tax treatment and the history behind it.

- **Estimates and orders**

Send, track, convert — the customer sees one continuous thread.

- **Invoices that reconcile**

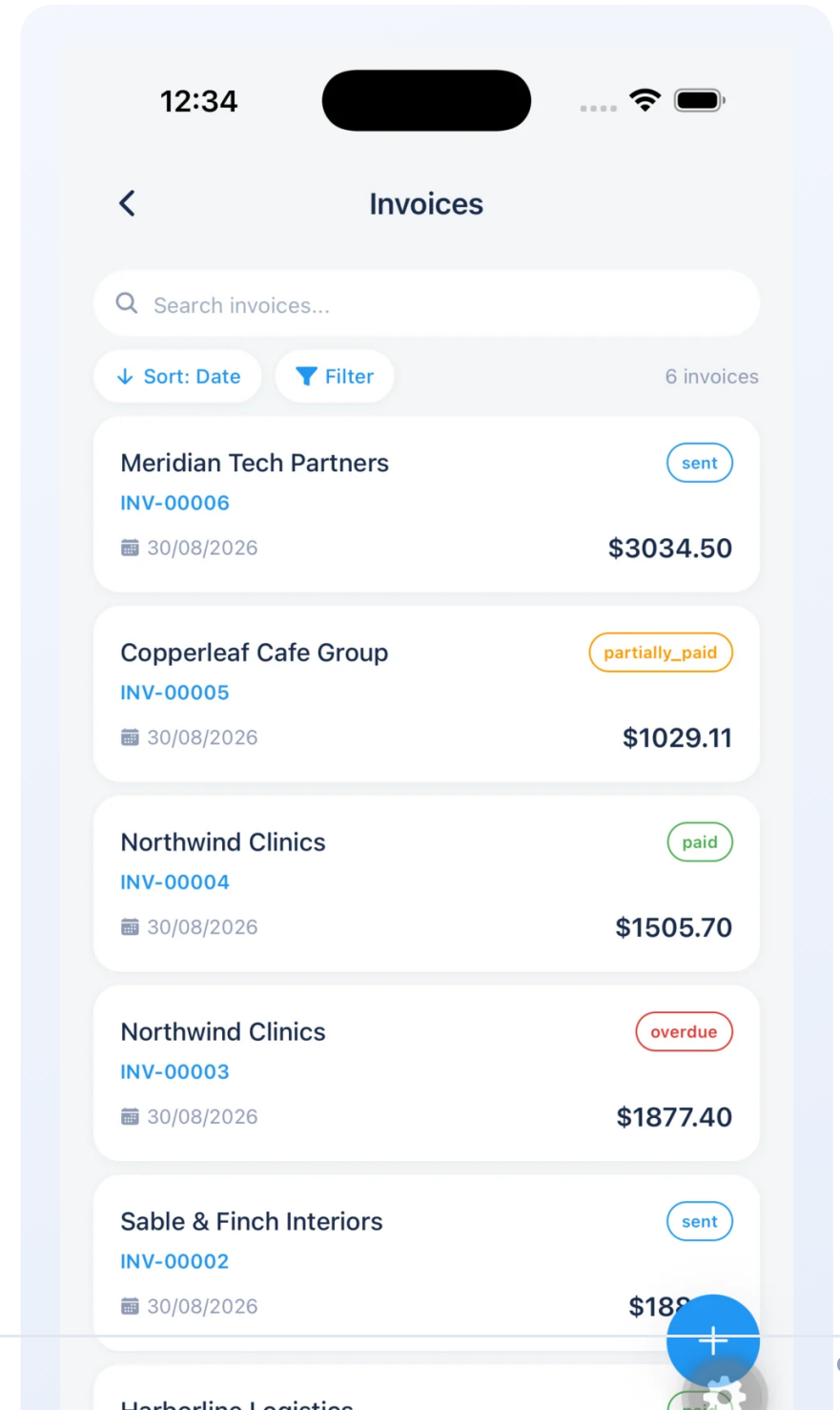
Per-line and document-level tax and discount, recomputed server-side.

- **Recurring and subscriptions**

Bill the same customer monthly without re-keying anything.

- **Credit notes and payments**

Refunds and part-payments land against the right document.



ITEMS

One catalogue behind every channel.

The same product record feeds the till, the trade portal, the online shop and the printed price list. Change it once.

- **Variants and units**

Size, colour, pack — priced and counted separately, grouped for reporting.

- **Price lists**

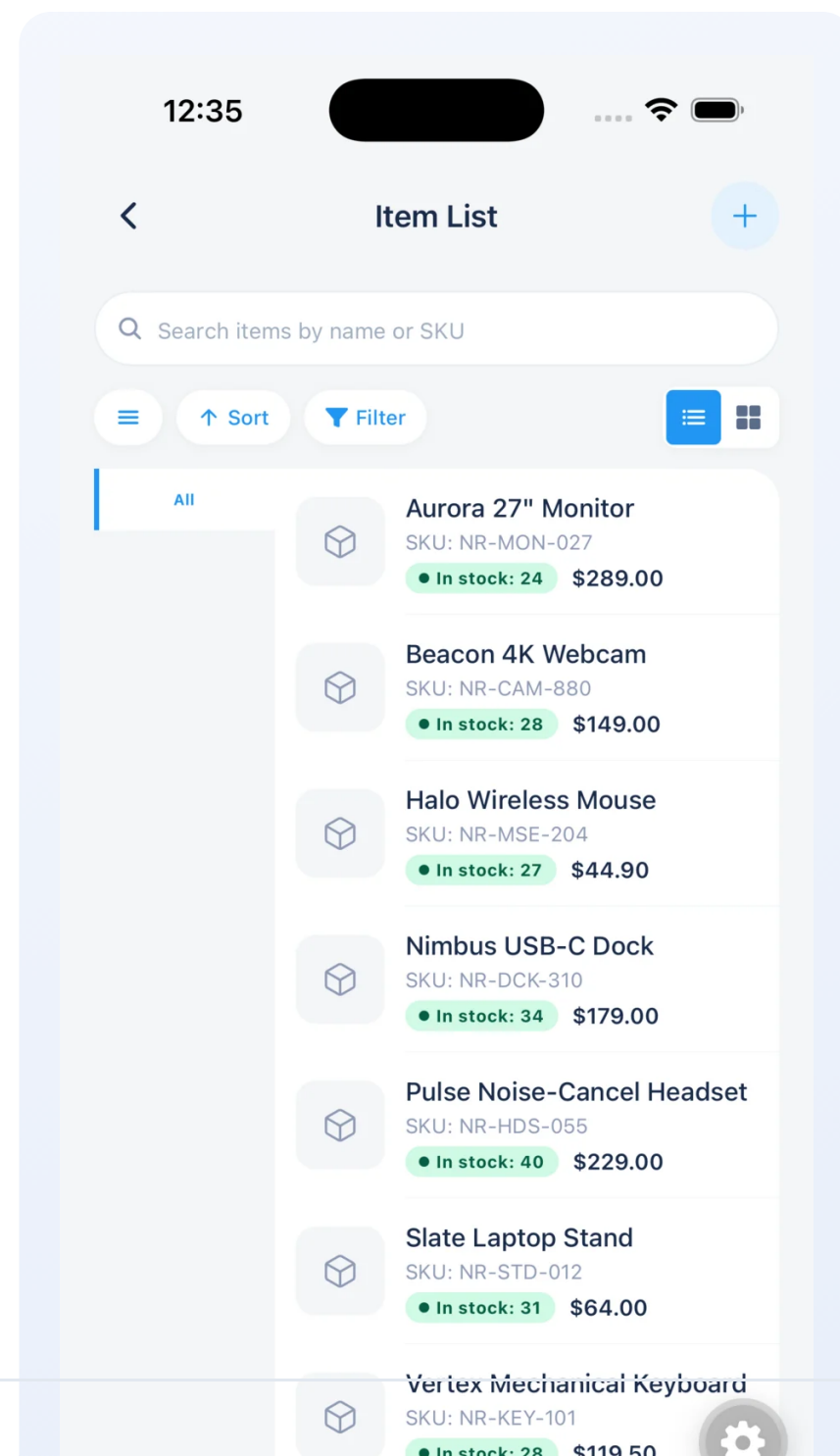
Per customer, per tier, per channel, with location overrides.

- **Barcodes and serials**

Scan to sell, scan to receive, track individual units through their life.

- **Brands and suppliers**

Who makes it, who supplies it, what it last cost.



INVENTORY

Stock you can actually trust.

Live levels per location, movements with a reason attached, and counts that reconcile rather than argue.

- **Multi-location**

Every site sees its own stock and the group total.

- **Batches and expiry**

Lot tracking for food, pharma and anything with a date on it.

- **Bins and zones**

Where in the warehouse, not just how many.

- **Reorder points**

Per location, so the busy branch does not run dry.



POINT OF SALE

A till that balances at close.

Built for the counter: fast, offline-tolerant and reconciled at the end of the shift rather than the end of the month.

- **Shifts and cash-up**

Open, sell, count, close — with the variance shown.

- **Any hardware**

Runs natively on the SUNMI lineup; peripherals auto-detected.

- **Offline-tolerant**

Keeps serving through a wobbly connection and syncs after.

- **One user, many stations**

The same login can hold a retail till and a restaurant till at once.



FOOD & BEVERAGE

The kitchen stops reading handwriting.

Orders go from the table to the pass the moment they are taken, and the bill follows the table across rounds and shift changes.

- **Tables and areas**

Floor plan, covers, and a bill that survives a server handover.

- **Kitchen display**

Tickets on screen, timed, in the order they should be cooked.

- **Table Sign**

A screen on the table: menu, order, call, and pay.

- **Menus, not just items**

Modifiers, courses and combos priced properly.



RETAIL

Every branch knows what the others have.

"Do you have it at the other shop?" answered from the shop floor, on a phone, in a second.

- **Live stock per site**

And transfers between them in two taps.

- **Loyalty**

Members, tiers, points and rewards that work at any till.

- **Promotions**

Time-boxed, per channel, per tier.

- **Customer display**

The second screen that shows the basket as it is scanned.



PURCHASE

What you owe, and what is on its way.

Requests become orders, orders become receipts, receipts become bills — with the numbers carried through instead of re-typed.

- **Requests and approvals**
Routed by rule, not by chasing someone.
- **Orders and receipts**
Partial deliveries handled without breaking the order.
- **Returns**
Back to the supplier with the credit tracked.
- **Vendor payments**
Against the right bill, with the balance visible.



ACCOUNTING

The books keep themselves current.

Expenses, bills and bank movement land as they happen, so the month-end is a review rather than a reconstruction.

- **Expenses**

Captured with a photo, categorised, approved.

- **Bank accounts**

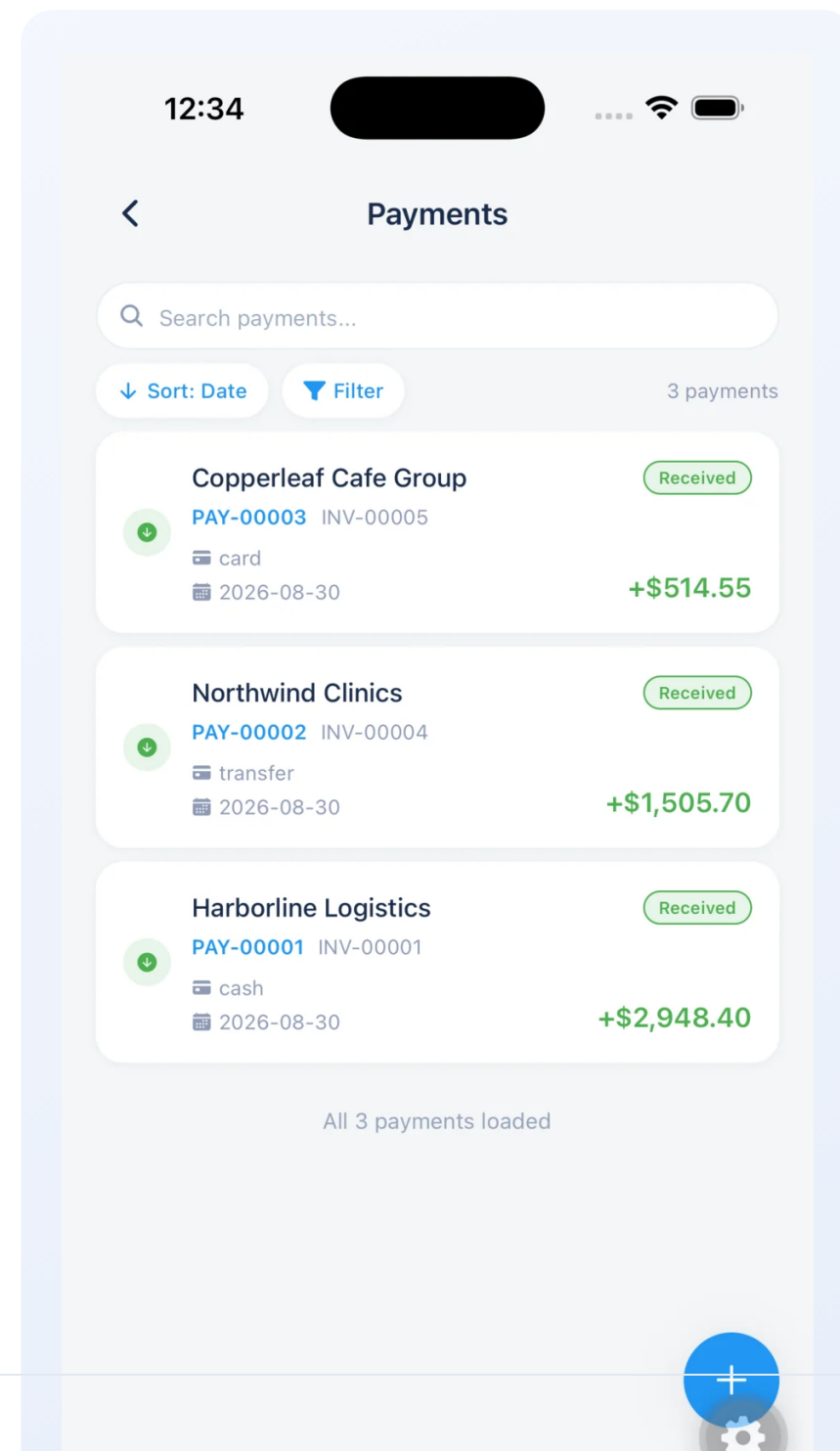
Transactions matched against what they paid for.

- **Tax rates**

Per line, per document, per jurisdiction.

- **Reports**

Aging, cash position and margin without an export.



CRM & MARKETING

The pipeline and the follow-up in one place.

Leads, deals and campaigns sit beside the customer record they belong to, so the person who calls already knows what was bought.

- **Leads and deals**

Stages, owners and the value in the pipeline.

- **Proposals**

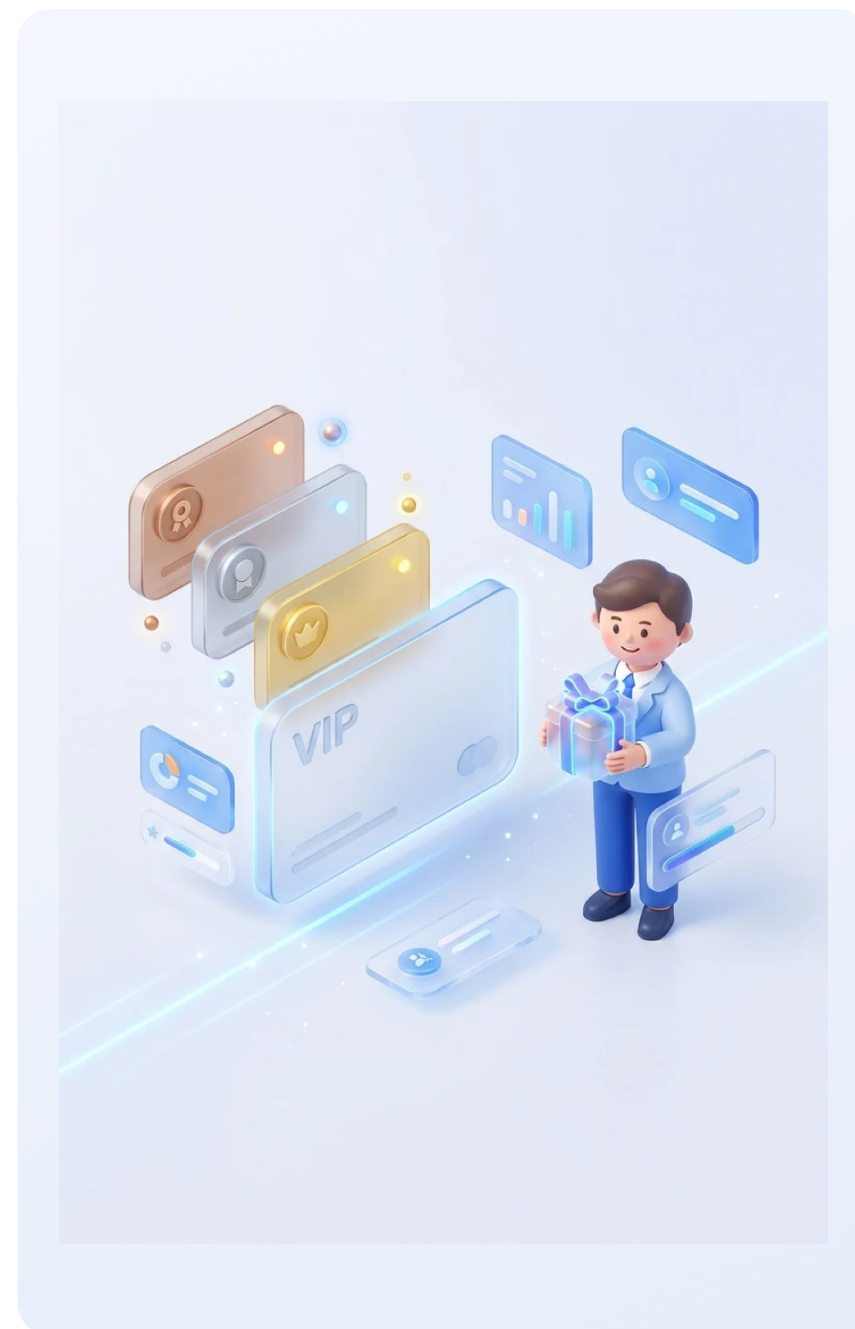
Sent, viewed, accepted — tracked.

- **Campaigns**

Segmented from real purchase history, not a guess.

- **Loyalty**

Tiers and rewards that pull people back.



PEOPLE

Rotas, hours and payroll on the same system as the till.

Attendance and timesheets feed the pay run, and the pay run feeds the books, with no spreadsheet in the middle.

- **Employees**
Records, documents, reviews and training.
- **Attendance**
Clock in at the terminal or on a phone.
- **Leave**
Requested, approved and reflected in the rota.
- **Payroll**
Payslips from hours actually worked.



FIELD SERVICE & LOGISTICS

Arrive knowing what you will find.

The job card carries the site, the equipment, its service history and the parts last fitted — so the van is packed for the actual job.

- **Jobs and technicians**
Scheduled, dispatched, tracked to completion.
- **Equipment history**
Every visit to that unit, in one thread.
- **Proof of delivery**
Signed on the phone with a photo and a timestamp.
- **Fleet and routes**
Drivers, vehicles, zones and carriers.



BOOKING

A diary that cannot double-book itself.

One calendar across sites and staff, with the customer booking themselves and the reminders going out on their own.

- **Services and staff**

Who can do what, and for how long.

- **Self-service**

Customers book without phoning anyone.

- **Reminders**

Fewer empty chairs.

- **Deposits**

Taken at booking, credited at checkout.



CIRCLE

Where the work gets talked about.

The collaboration layer: chat, huddles, shared documents and tasks — attached to the records they are about, not in a separate app.

- **Chat and presence**

Per team and per document.

- **Live co-editing**

Two people on one invoice, with a save both must confirm.

- **Tasks and projects**

A comment becomes a task without leaving the thread.

- **Kardo AI**

Ask your own data a question from any screen.

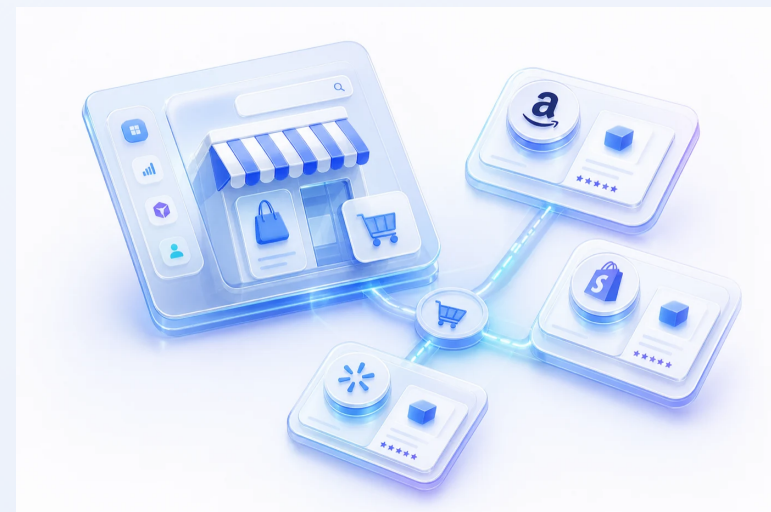


COMMERCE

Every route to market, one catalogue.

Wholesale, resellers, distributors and your own shopfronts — priced by tier and settled centrally.

- **B2B portal**
Trade buyers ordering on account, at their own terms.
- **Partners and tiers**
Their price, their commission, their credit limit.
- **Storefronts**
Branded, on your own handle.
- **Settlement**
Who owes what, netted and reported.



SPACES

Selling where people already are.

The consumer-facing side: a social storefront with live streams, group buys and gift cards, tied to the same stock and the same prices.

- **Live shopping**
Stream, tag products, take orders in the room.
- **Social storefront**
Posts, stories and a shop in one place.
- **Group buys**
Price that drops as the group grows.
- **Gift cards**
Issued, redeemed and reconciled at any till.



DEVICES

The certified lineup.

Fourteen SUNMI models, pre-flashed and auto-configured. Unbox, sign in, sell — the peripherals are detected for you.

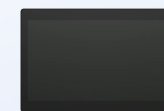

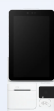

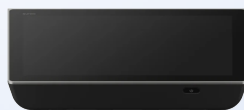

Open, and yours to build on.

One read API across 30 modules and 133 resources, one key, and a catalogue the API hands you itself.

- **One key, one base URL**

The same query grammar reaches every module.

- **Scoped permissions**

A key scoped to items gets items — and nothing else.

- **Read-only by design**

An integration that misbehaves cannot void an invoice.

- **Your data, exportable**

Open APIs and standards-based hardware. No lock-in.
